### What is a Hackathon?

Hack@WPI is a hackathon run by WPI's ACM Student Chapter that is open to both hardware and software hacks. It has no theme, so students have the freedom to create whatever they want.

During the hackathon, there are a variety of workshops in which the attendees can participate. One such workshop is Team Formation & Brainstorming where students pitch their ideas to recruit teammates that have relevant skills or interests. We also hold other workshops run by students or alumni to help hackers learn new technologies.

### What Format Will the Hackathon be in?

This year, Hack@WPI will be using a hybrid format to allow participants to join in-person or from home. The expected head count is 200 hackers.


The event will take place over the weekend on January 14-16, 2022. In-person participants are invited to stay overnight and continue hacking.




